



ORDER NO. 19-14-02
USDA FOREST SERVICE
LAKE TAHOE BASIN MANAGEMENT UNIT
UTR REACH 5 RESTORATION PROJECT CLOSURE AREA



Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. This Order is effective from June 15, 2014 through October 15, 2014.

Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the UTR Reach 5 Restoration Project Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map.
36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service, specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons with a special use permit or contract from the Forest Service authorizing work within the UTR Reach 5 Restoration Project Closure Area and their employees, sub-contractors, or agents are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent authorized by the special use permit or contract.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.
16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.



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Exhibit A

UTR Reach 5 Restoration Project Closure Area 1 -- The boundary of the UTR Reach 5 Restoration Project Closure Area 1 begins at a point 470 feet due west from the northern end of Muskwaki Drive on the boundary of the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit, then continues 600 feet due west along the northern forest boundary, then continues 500 feet due south, then continues 440 feet due east to its intersection with the forest boundary, then continues 508 feet northeasterly along the eastern edge of the forest boundary, back to the starting point.

UTR Reach 5 Restoration Project Closure Area 2 -- The boundary of the UTR Reach 5 Restoration Project Closure Area 2 begins at the intersection of the temporary project access road and the forest boundary, approximately 450 feet at 300 degrees northwest from the western end of Nottaway Drive, then continues due north 3,310 feet along the forest boundary, then continues 1,136 feet at 114 degrees southeast to its intersection with the eastern edge of the forest boundary, then continues 1,115 feet along the forest boundary to its intersection with the temporary project access road, then continues approximately 1,875 feet southwesterly along the temporary project access road back to the starting point.
