Dear County Line Farms Limited:

I want to start by thanking you for your continued management on the Anita / Cameron Allotment. As requested on May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2014, I am amending your Annual Operating Instructions (AOI) for the 2014 grazing year, authorizing you to utilize the Anita / Cameron Allotment as follows:

Pasture	Time Frame
Dillman	04/01-06/30 (200 cow/calf)
Basin East	04/01-05/26 (380 cow/calf)
Bucklar	07/01-11/15 (200 cow/calf)
East Skinner	08/21-11/15 (440 cow/calf)
Airport	04/01-07/01 (30 Horses)
Basin West	05/27-07/27 (400 cow/calf)
Trash Dam	07/01-08/20 (440 cow/calf)
Deer Pasture	08/21-11/01 (440 cow/calf)
Basin Trap	11/02-11/10 (440 cow/calf)
Deer Pasture	11/11-11/15 (440 cow/calf)

Please notify us of cattle movements onto and off of the allotments, as well as refinements that may be needed to enhance the management system. If you identify the need to differ from this management system by more than 14 days, please contact District Range personnel at least two weeks in advance so that we have time to conduct monitoring and assess your request.

If utilization levels within portions of a scheduled pasture approach allowable use, you are required to move livestock into areas not approaching allowable use. If cattle cannot be effectively managed away from areas within the pasture that have met allowable use or if utilization objectives are met throughout the pasture prior to scheduled rotation, contact District Range personnel. Cattle will be moved into the next available pasture within the annual rotation. In the event that forage utilization objectives are met in all available pastures, livestock will be removed from the allotment. Management adjustments will be made to the following years Annual Operating Instructions to avoid recurring situations.
