

To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this letter as official delegation of authority for Tribal Representation on wildland fire incidents occurring during the 2014 fire season. The Designated Tribal Representatives are identified on the attached Government to Government Fire Management Coordination Form. This delegation is concerning governmental cooperation concerning wildland fire incidents on the Si Rivers and Klamath National Forests potentially affecting the rights, resources, practices, or jurisdiction of the Karuk Tribe.

The identified Designated Tribal Government Representative(s) are delegated the authority to be the point of contact on behalf of the Karuk Tribe for expedited incident consultation regarding Tribal issues, concerns, beliefs and interests regarding incident response actions and activities; as well as for coordination with tribal planning efforts with response activities; identification of additional needs to be enacted in accordance with the abovementioned MOU; and the appropriate utilization of Tribal Wildland Fire Management Resources. If unresolved issues arise during the course of an incident or activity, such representative will confer the situation with the Tribal Council and Self-Governance Coordinator for the purposes of determining any appropriate course of action in relation to or beyond the scope of the MOU or this delegation of authority.

Thank you for your dedication to cooperation, coordination, and consultation in the interest of achieving mutual benefit in relation to wildland fire management.

Individuals performing other duties in the MOU will be selected by the Tribal Representative in consultation with the agency administrator or Incident Commander at the time of the incident. Positions with qualification requirements will possess a valid Red Card with the CULS qualification, and those that do not have qualification requirements will be accompanied by a single resource qualified individual for duties performed in the fire area.
