

ORDER
BILL WILLIAMS MOUNTAIN WATERSHED CLOSURE
KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551, and 36 CFR § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands within the Williams Ranger District, Kaibab National Forest, in Coconino County within the state of Arizona. The closure area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Going into or being upon the Bill Williams Mountain Watershed; **36 CFR §261.52(e)**.
2. Being on a road within the Bill Williams Mountain Watershed; **36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e)**.
3. Being on a trail within the Bill Williams Mountain Watershed; **36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a)**.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force or other authorized personnel in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a written permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.

BILL WILLIAMS MOUNTAIN WATERSHED CLOSURE AREA DESCRIPTION:

National Forest System lands bounded to the east by 4th Street and County Road 73, to the south by Forest Service Road (FSR) 122, to the west by FSR 108 and to the north by Interstate 40.

PURPOSE:

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to high fire danger.

1. This Order becomes effective at 8:00 a.m., June 6, 2014 and will remain in force until rescinded or until August 1, 2014, whichever event occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed in Exhibit A.
