Fuel Wood Permit Required

Wrights Lake Campground was hit by high winds over the winter, bringing down numerous large trees. The Pacific Ranger District of the Eldorado National Forest is opening the area up to residential fuel woodcutting during limited dates and times as a part of the clean-up effort. Members of the public with a **valid Forest Product Removal Permit for fuel wood and a special exemption notice** will be allowed to cut and remove wood during this special event.
