**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on lands as described in this order, all within the Sawtooth National Recreation Area, Sawtooth National Forest. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the area as described in this order. 36 CFR 261.54(b) Machinery, Motorized, Non-Motorized, Pedestrian, Stock

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

1. Intersection of Forest Service Road (FSR) 210 and FSR 315. TSN, R14E, SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 8. Described as where the FSR 210 and Hell Roaring roads intercept. Closing FSR 210 North to T10N, R13E, NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section 36 the north closure is approximately 1.0 miles south of Forest Service Road 214 (Redfish road). See map . . . . .

**PURPOSE:**

This Order is necessary to increase public safety by restricting traffic on the described road to only vehicles working on the Gold Fire.


**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this order.

3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. § 551, 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581(b)(7).
4. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the area (and/or roads, trails) covered by this order.
