ORDER

Pursuant to Public Law 16 USC, Section 551, TITLE 36 CFR 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited in the area listed and described in this order within the Tongass National Forest, Chatham Area, Juneau Ranger District, until further notice (see attached Exhibit A).

(1) Occupancy and/or foot traffic is not permitted within 100 yards of an island in Mendenhall Lake, known as Tern Island, and described in exhibit A, from April 1 to September 30. This closure is implemented for the protection of Artic Tern nesting and rearing habitat. 36 CFR 261.53 (b).

(2) Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e)(1) and (4), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1) Persons with a permit.

4) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
