OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), it is hereby ordered that the following prohibitions hereinafter set forth, apply from June 15 to September 15, yearly; to all National Forest System Lands and waters within 900 (nine hundred) feet of the following described portion of Anan Creek Forest Development Trail (#448).

- (1) Beginning at the Anan Bay Recreation Cabin, a developed recreation site, and continuing south on the trail which is located just above the beach, paralleling the shore to its terminus at the Anan Bear Observatory.

As provided by this order, the following is prohibited:

- (1) Possessing, storing or transporting any Dog- to include any of the various animals of family Canidae; 36 CFR 261.58(s).

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the prohibition in this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.


(2) Any Federal or State officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

(3) Persons whose vision is impaired and who require a seeing-eye dog.


This order is effective beginning September 16, 1994 and will remain in effect until rescinded.

This prohibition applies to the above described area in proximity of the Anan Creek forest development trail shown on the attached map and beginning at the head of a small cove in Anan Bay, approximately three miles east of the mouth of Bradfield Canal at Ernest Sound in the Alexander Archipelago - Township 65 South, Range 87 East, Section 36, Copper River Meridian.

Violation of any of the prohibitions set forth above is prohibited, and/or punishable by the provisions of the regulations cited, and under Title 16 USC 551 and Title 18 USC 3571. Any violation is subject to punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals or \$10,000 for organizations; and/or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months.
