ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
STIKINE AREA
TONGASS NATIONAL FOREST

Order No. 94-4

FIRE

Pursuant to Title 36, CFR, Sec. 261.50(a), it is hereby ordered that the following acts hereinafter set forth are prohibited, and applies to all National Forest System Lands and Waters, within the Stikine Area of the Tongass National Forest, until further notice.

- (1) Possessing, discharging or using any kind of firework or other pyrotechnic device, 36 CFR 261.52(f).

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the prohibition in this order:


- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

(3) Any person meeting exemption requirements specified in the order:

(a) Persons with a U.S. Forest Service, contract or approved operating plan; which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

(b) Persons possessing, discharging or using for emergency purposes, any aircraft or marine emergency flares or fusees.

Violation of any of the prohibitions set forth above is prohibited, and punishable by the provisions of the regulations cited, and under Title 16 USC; 551; and Title 18 USC; 3571. Any violation is subject to punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals or \$10,000 for organizations; and/or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months.
