OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to Title 36, CFR, §261.50(a) and (b), it is hereby ordered that the following acts hereinafter set forth are prohibited, and applies to National Forest System Lands, Forest Development roads, and trails within the Stikine Area of the Tongass National Forest, until further notice.

(1) Camping in excess of 14 days at one location, during any 90 day period, 36 CFR 261.58(a).


Subsequent camping location(s) must be at least one half (0.5) mile from any previous location,

Pursuant to Title 36, CFR, §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the prohibition in this order:

(1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

(2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of any of the prohibitions set forth above is prohibited, and/or punishable by the provisions of the regulations cited, and under Title 16 USC §551; and Title 18 USC §3571. Any violation is subject to punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals or \$10,000 for organizations; and/or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months.
