Portion of Medicine Bow National Forest Road 100 to be Temporarily Closed

(SARATOGA, Wyo.) June 9, 2014 – Beginning on June 16, Forest Road 100 on the Brush Creek-Hayden Ranger District of the Medicine Bow National Forest is scheduled to be temporarily closed for hazard tree removal. This road is also known as the North Brush Creek Road.

Closures will generally occur Monday – Friday each week during operating hours with night and weekend openings. Forest visitors planning to use this road should note the following information:

- Specific hours for the closure are Monday 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.; Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 5:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.; and Friday 5:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- The road will be closed in segments where timber removal is occurring. The first closure segment is between the junction with Forest Road 200 and the private land boundary at Tenmile. Closures will move north towards Turpin Reservoir. Progress of work will be dependent on snow melt and ground conditions.

The Forest Service regrets any inconvenience these or other closures may cause the public; however, roadside hazard tree removal is needed to ensure long-term public safety.

Visitors to this part of the Medicine Bow National Forest are encouraged to check the status of work areas by calling 307-326-5258 or stopping by the BCH Ranger District office at 2171 S. Highway 130 in Saratoga between 7:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, this summer.
