**ROAD, RECREATION RESIDENCE AND RECREATION SITE FLOOD CLOSURE AREA**

Pursuant to *16 USC 551* and *36 CFR 261.50 (a)* and *(b)*, the following acts are prohibited on the roads and in the areas as described in this order, and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A (the "restricted area"), all within the Pecos/Las Vegas Ranger District, Santa Fe National Forest, San Miguel County, New Mexico:

**PROHIBITIONS**

1. Entering or being upon Holy Ghost Canyon NFS Road 122, Holy Ghost Summer Home Tract Area, Holy Ghost Campground, Holy Ghost Group Site, or Holy Ghost Trailhead. **36 CFR 261.53(e)**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to *36 CFR 261.50 (e)*, the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Landowners crossing National Forest System lands in order to access their private property.
4. Any persons authorized by a valid contract, operating plan, or special use authorization.

**AREAS DESCRIBED**

The restricted area includes the following recreation residence tracts and sites and the entire length of all of the following National Forest System Roads on NFS land and the lands surrounding those roads in T18N, R12E, Sections 20, 29, 32, and 33 as described below and as depicted on the attached map at Exhibit A:

- Holy Ghost Canyon (NFS Road 122)
- Holy Ghost Summer Home Tract Area
- Holy Ghost Campground
- Holy Ghost Group Site
- Holy Ghost Trailhead


## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this closure is for the protection of public health and safety during potential flooding along road(s), and areas as described unsafe for the public to travel or visit within the Pecos/Las Vegas Ranger District Road, Recreation Residence Tract, and Recreation Sites and Flood Closure Area.

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

1. The prohibitions contained in this order are effective from date of signature through September 30, 2014, or until the order is rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581]




**Pecos/Las Vegas RD 2014
