CAMPGROUNDS: SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND ADVISORIES

NOTES: * Fees shown are single/double site per night fees. Site fee covers the number of vehicles permitted by occupancy and use regulations. Single sites allow a maximum of 8 people, 2 vehicles, 2 tents, and 1 trailer. Double sites allow a maximum of 12 people, 3 vehicles, 3 tents, and 2 trailers, Extra vehicles, at \$5.00 per vehicle, are allowed as long as other occupancy limits are met. These extra vehicles must park in designated overflow parking areas. Fees are charged until the campground is closed. At Mottet, Target Meadows, and Woodland Campgrounds fees are charged through October 15.

Campground Operating Season – The primary camping season on the Walla Walla Ranger District is July 4 through Labor Day Weekend (depending on road conditions) with the exception of Umatilla Forks Campground which, due to its lower elevation, opens around Memorial Day. Roads in the Tollgate area are usually snowed closed until mid to late June. Earlier openings may occur if weather and road conditions permit.

SPRING CAMPING

Jubilee Lake – Closed. Expect the campground to open by July 4th weekend.

Woodward – Closed. Expect the campground to open by July 4th weekend.

Target Meadows – Closed. Expect the campground to open by July 4th weekend.

Umatilla Forks – All sites are now open.

Woodland – Closed. Expect the campground to open mid to late June.

Mottet – Closed. Expect the campground to be opening no earlier than mid-July.
