Alcoholic Beverage Restriction

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the following areas on the Grandfather Ranger District of the Pisgah National Forest: **Curtis Creek Recreation Area, specifically Forest System Road 482 and 1000 feet from either side of the roadway, within the recreation area.** This closure order is effective from June 13, 2014 to June 13, 2019.


- 1. Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by state law. 36 CFR 261.58(BB).**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit or contract specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This prohibition is in addition to general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions set forth above is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for and organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. 551, 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
