

**TEMPORARY AREA AND USE RESTRICTIONS
FOREST SERVICE SYSTEM TRAILS**

DESCHUTES NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC, Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following special restrictions and prohibitions are established on Forest trails, and within the boundary lines of the Two Bulls Fire Area on the Deschutes National Forest, Bend Ft. Rock and Sisters Ranger Districts, where signed on the ground and as shown on the attached map and described in the map legend, hereby incorporated into this order as attachment A.

Closed Forest Service System Trails: Mrazek trail as shown on Attachment A from the intersection with Forest Service System Road 4609015 southwest for approximately 0.5 mile.

PROHIBITIONS

Being on a trail. 36 CFR § 261.55(a)

This restriction is in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36CFR§261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR§261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Personnel with written authorization by a Forest Officer, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act. The issuing Officer may include such conditions as are considered necessary for the protection of the area, or for the promotion of the health, safety, or welfare of its users.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or volunteer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons under a special use authorization that allows the otherwise prohibited action, and approved contractors and their agents directly engaged in approved work outlined in an operating plan or permit.

This closure is enacted due to firefighting activities taking place within the closure area, and for the protection of public and employee safety.

This order supersedes Order Number 06-01-01-14-001-1, which is hereby rescinded.

This order becomes effective at 0001, June 24 , 2014, and will remain in force until rescinded.




