***Occupancy and Use*  
TURPIN MEADOW CAMPGROUND AREA  
Camping Restriction**

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following act is prohibited in the Turpin Meadow Campground, within the area ¼ mile from the outer boundary of Turpin Meadow Campground, and Turpin Meadow itself, within the Buffalo Ranger District on the Bridger-Teton National Forest until further notice. This order is not temporary in nature, but shall remain in effect so long as this area exhibits a high risk for human/grizzly bear conflict.

1. Camping except in a hard-sided RV, camper, or trailer within the restricted area.  
**36 CFR 261.58 (e)** (See attached map)

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**DEFINITIONS:**

*Camping* means the temporary use of National Forest System lands for the purpose of overnight occupancy without a permanently-fixed structure.

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this order is to protect human life and provide for public safety because of a high level of activity by grizzly bear in this area.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

National Forest area as shown on the attached map bounded on the south by the Buffalo Fork River, at its juncture with Buffalo Valley Road, follows the road to the point where it intersects the power-line that serves the recreation residences. Following the power-line and continuing in a clockwise direction, the closure area encompasses Turpin Meadow just above the Turpin Meadow Recreation Residences Loop. The east side of the closure continues to follow the

outside of the Recreation Residence Loop until it meets the ¼ mile buffer that surrounds the campground itself, all within Teton County, Wyoming.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice;
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.




