The Macedon Fire Salvage Timber Sale is located within Sections 1, 2, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 23 & 24 of T15N, R12E and Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 17, 18 & 19 of T15N, R13E MDM. The Forest Service will receive sealed bids in public at Nevada City at 10:00 AM local time on 07/14/2014 for an estimated volume of 3803.8 MBF of Douglas Fir sawtimber, 403.62 MBF of Incense Cedar sawtimber, 0.23 MBF of Lodgepole Pine sawtimber, 4146.98 MBF of Ponderosa Pine sawtimber, 6455.18 MBF of Sugar Pine sawtimber, and 5835.64 MBF of White Fir sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of Combined Hardwood non-saw, Combined Softwood cull logs, Salvage Douglas Fir sawtimber, Salvage Incense Cedar sawtimber, Salvage Ponderosa Pine sawtimber, Salvage Sugar Pine sawtimber, and Salvage White Fir sawtimber that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate. Sale contains specified roads with an estimated public works construction cost of \$325,756.46. Bidders qualifying as small business concerns under the Small Business Act may, when submitting a bid, elect for the Forest Service to build permanent roads.
