EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest. This temporary restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations and will remain in effect from June 10, 2014 through October 1, 2014 unless rescinded earlier.

36 CFR 261.54 – National Forest System Roads: When provided by an order the following act is prohibited: Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the order [Title 36 CFR 261.54(a)].

For the purpose of this order, the Road described as Forest Service Road No. 7303 (Mill Gulch Road) is closed to all motorized vehicles for public safety (due to a major washout making the road impassible) from June 10, 2014 through October 1, 2014 unless rescinded earlier. The closure area description follows with a map attachment.


Description of the road – The Mill Creek Road No.7303 - Closure begins at the Washout. Legal description Twp 5 S Range 3W SE ¼ Sec. 3

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Owners or lessees of land in the area.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Penalty:

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571).
