Alcohol Beverage Restriction

Avery Creek Road Area – NFSR 477


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited in the following areas on the Pisgah Ranger District of the Pisgah National Forest: Avery Creek Road Area NFSR 477, specifically the entire length of the road and 1,000 feet from either side of the roadway as indicated on the closure map. This order is effective from July 21, 2014 until July 21, 2019.

- 1. Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by state law.**
36 CFR 261.58 (bb)

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons or areas are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a special use permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission, issued by the District Ranger.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons with a valid reservation occupying the White Pines Group Campgrounds (A) administered under permit from the Cradle of Forestry Interpretation Association.
4. Visitors of the Pisgah Stables (B) operating under permit from the National Forest in North Carolina.

Violation of these prohibitions set forth above is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. See 16 U.S.C. 551, 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.
