

ORDER

FIRE & OFF ROAD VEHICLE USE

USDA – FOREST SERVICE MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the Restriction Area identified in Attachment A on the Mt Hood National Forest. This order is effective at 0001 hours, July 11th, 2014, until rescinded.

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire or charcoal fire, except in locations described in Attachment B. 36 CFR 261.52 (a)
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed campground or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter, which is barren or cleared of all flammable material. 36 CFR 261.52 (d)
3. Operating an internal combustion engine except a motor vehicle on National Forest System Roads, or designated parking areas. 36 CFR 261.52 (h)
4. Possessing or using motorized vehicles on National Forest systems trails 36 CFR 261.55(b)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons or activities are exempt from these prohibitions:

1. Persons with a permit, waiver or contract specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Building, maintaining, attending or using a campfire or charcoal fire in a developed recreational site listed on Attachment B.
