

FOREST ORDER**USDA FOREST SERVICE
BIGHORN NATIONAL FOREST
Medicine Wheel / Paintrock Ranger District****AREA CLOSURE
Roane Creek Fire Area**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Roane Creek Fire Area on the Bighorn National Forest, Big Horn County, Wyoming. All "restricted areas" and on all roads and trails located within the Restricted Area: north end of Forest Service Roads 121, 122, 131, 132, and Forest Service Trails 104 and 151. The Restricted Area and the Restricted Roads and Trails are depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A.

The purpose of this Order is to protect natural resources and public safety due to the impacts of the Roane Creek Fire.

PROHIBITIONS:

- 1) Going into or being upon the Restricted Area. 36 CFR § 261.53(e) and 36 CFR § 261.52(e).
- 2) Being on the Restricted Roads. 36 CFR § 261.54(e).
- 3) Being on the Restricted Trails. 36 CFR § 261.55(a).


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force, in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This order becomes effective at 12:01 am on July 25, 2014, and remains in effect until rescinded, or through December 31, 2014, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a legal entity other than an individual, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571).
