Location: Sheeprock Mountains, North and East of Erickson Pass, Tooele County, Spanish Fork Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest

Cause: Lightning

Size: 670 acres

Fuels: Grass, brush and Pinyon

Resources: 2 Type 1 crews, 1 type 2 crew, 2 engines, 1 water tender, and 1 Type 3 helicopter

Fire Behavior: Isolated torching with small runs
