Incident Name: Spring Canyon Fire

Date: July 27, 2014

Time: 0800 am

Start Date: July 26, 2014 Reported at 2:20 am

Location: The fire is located 1 miles east of Springville, Utah

Cause: Human - Fireworks

Size: Approx. 140 acres

Fuels: Grass and oak brush

Resources: 3 Helicopters, 4 hand crews, 1 Hotshot crew and 3 engines

Fire Behavior: active flame front burning at mid-slope

Containment: 15%

Evacuations: Approx. 10 homes were evacuated on the morning of July 26. All residents have returned to their homes.

Closures: Roads leading in and around the fire are closed for public safety.

Remarks: The fire is burning adjacent to the town of Springville, Utah between Spring Canyon and Hobble Canyon. Ground crews will continue to build fire line and work with helicopters to facilitate water drops.

The fire is being managed by a local Type III Incident Management Team made up of US Forest Service, Forestry Fire and State Lands, Bureau of Land Management, Utah County Fire and Unified Fire Authority.
