

**ORDER NO. 14-05-736**  
**KLAMATH AND SIX RIVERS NATIONAL FORESTS**  
**Temporary Forest Order**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Orleans/Ukonom Ranger District of the Klamath and Six Rivers National Forests. This Order is effective from September 20, 2014 through September 29, 2014.

Going into or being upon the following areas on the Klamath River, as shown on the attached map.

1. Ishi Pishi Bridge River Access Area.
2. George Geary River Access Area.
3. Green Riffle River Access Area.

36 CFR 261.53(g).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Members of the Karuk Tribe.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine or not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
