



Order No. 19-14-12
USDA Forest Service
Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit
South Shore Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. This Order is effective from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., July 28, 2014, through November 15, 2014.

Going into or being upon Unit 5, Unit 188, and Unit 189 of the South Shore Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project, as described on Exhibit A and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons with a contract from the Forest Service authorizing work on the South Shore Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent authorized by the contract.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.

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Exhibit A

The boundary of Unit 5 begins at a point 45 feet north of Highway 50 at the Forest boundary, then continues 440 feet due north, then continues 650 feet to the northwest at an angle of 311 degrees to the Forest boundary, then continues 285 feet west along the Forest boundary to the Upper Truckee River, then continues south 966 feet along the Upper Truckee River to the Forest Boundary, then continues 280 feet to the northeast at an angle of 10 degrees, then continues 214 feet to the northeast at an angle of 59 degrees, then continues 483 feet to the southeast at an angle of 153 degrees back to the starting point.

The boundary of Unit 188 begins at the intersection of North Upper Truckee Road and Highway 50, then continues 675 feet east along Highway 50, then continues 650 feet to the northwest at an angle of 292 degrees, then continues 200 feet to the northwest at an angle of 336 degrees, then continues 605 feet due west to North Upper Truckee Road, then continues south 1560 feet along North Upper Truckee Road back to the starting point

The boundary of Unit 189 begins at the Forest boundary 150 feet due north of the eastern end of Chilicothe Street at the boundary of Washoe Meadows State Park, then continues 670 feet east along the Forest boundary to the Upper Truckee River, then continues .7 miles south along the Upper Truckee River, then continues 428 feet to the northwest at an angle of 331 degrees, then continues 260 feet to the northwest at an angle of 276 degrees, then continues 190 feet to the southwest at an angle of 163 degrees, then continues 284 feet to the southwest at an angle of 205 degrees, then continues 151 feet to the southeast at an angle of 169 degrees, then continues 155 feet to the southeast at an angle of 113 degrees, then continues 610 feet to the southeast at an angle of 156 degrees, then continues 605 feet due west to North Upper Truckee Road, then continues 300 feet north along North Upper Truckee Road, then continues 177 feet to the northeast at an angle of 50 degrees, then continues .75 miles north along the Forest boundary back to the starting point.
