**TEMPORARY CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY**

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a ) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order on the Cedar City Ranger District, Dixie National Forest, until further notice:

1. Any overnight camping in the Deer Valley area. [Title 36 CFR 261.53 (E)]

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from the prohibition contained in this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)]
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)]
3. Federal of State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

It is prohibited to overnight camp in any areas off of the following Forest Service roads in the Deer Valley area-

Forest Service Roads- **055, 1635, 1642, 1663**

The above described area is within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the Dixie National Forest, within the counties of Iron and Kane, State of Utah.

**PURPOSE/DURATION:**

This order is intended to close areas to overnight camping due to logging operations in the Deer Valley area. This order will remain in effect until logging operations have been completed.


**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. The prohibitions in this order apply to areas that are posted. Signs will remain posted until the Forest Service determines that the threat has subsided.
2. A map identifying the areas that may be posted is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 15 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].
4. Further information regarding this order may be obtained at the Cedar City Ranger District office located in Cedar City, Utah, telephone number (435) 865-3200; and at the Dixie National Forest Supervisor's Office in Cedar City, Utah, telephone number (435) 865-3700.
5. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order on roads covered by this order.
