Two Campgrounds Temporarily Open to Firewood Gathering in Laramie Area

(LARAMIE, Wyo.) August 4, 2014 – The upper loops of Rob Roy Campground and Pole Creek Group Campground have temporarily been opened to the public for firewood collection with a personal-use permit.

Both campgrounds are on the Laramie Ranger District (LRD) of the Medicine Bow National Forest and have available firewood due to hazard tree removal projects.

Firewood in these areas is available on a first-come, first-serve basis, and both require a personal-use firewood permit, \$10/cord, minimum of \$20.

Permits can be obtained at the LRD Office, 2468 Jackson Street in Laramie from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Pole Creek Campground is currently the only location on the Pole Mountain unit where firewood collection is allowed.

Both areas remain closed to camping.

The following information should be noted by those utilizing these areas:

- Do not cut standing trees in the campground.
- Park safely and do not obstruct traffic.
- Be aware of your safety and the safety of others.
- All conditions listed on personal-use firewood permit apply.
- Equipment use is not allowed.
