INTEGRATED RESOURCE TIMBER CONTRACT DELANEY STEWARDSHIP

COLVILLE NATIONAL FOREST

The Delaney Stewardship Contract is located within T32N, R42E Sections 9,10,15-17,19-22,24-28,33-36; T32N, R43E Sections 19,30, W.M. Surveyed, Pend Oreille County, Washington. The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at Colville National Forest Supervisor's Office, 765 S. Main St., Colville, Washington no later than 4:30 PM local time on or before 09/22/2014 for an estimated volume of 83,062 tons of Douglas-fir and Other Coniferous Species Sawtimber, 41,357 tons of Grand-fir Hemlock Sawtimber and 11,196 tons of Grn Bio Cv marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, the contract area contains an unestimated volume of Miscellaneous Forest Products Grn Bio Cv that the offeror may agree to remove at a fixed rate. Also included in the contract are ten (10) mandatory and eleven (11) optional restorative service projects to be completed by the contractor. The contract will be awarded based on a Best Value determination. One award will be made to the offeror (a) whose proposal is technically acceptable and (b) whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus from the office listed below. A prospectus, offer form, and complete information concerning the timber, the restoration service projects, the conditions of sale, and submission of offers are available to the public from the Supervisor's Office, 765 S Main, Colville, Washington.
