## BOY SCOUT TRAIL #126

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Boy Scout Trail #126 connects the Turley Trail, maintained by the county, with Ranch Trail #62. TR 126 starts at the Forest boundary and follows a winding ravine, passing above rock-strewn gullies that may contain water. It is an uphill climb through scrub oak and pine to the junction with TR 62. Although the overall elevation change is modest, it is enough to affect the vegetation, and the upper reaches of TR 126 lie within dense ponderosa pine forest. This trail, in combination with TR 62, Sevenmile Gulch Trail #9854, and Watershed Trail #299, provides access to the rugged area south of Spruce Mountain.

**CAUTION: This trail is open to hikers, horseback riders and mountain bicyclists. Please be considerate of others—slow down and know when to yield the trail.**

**ACCESS AND TRAILHEAD LOCATION:** TR 126 can be accessed via the Turley Trail or TR 62. To reach the Turley Trail, travel east on Gurley Street for 1 mile past the Courthouse Square to its junction with Overland Road. Turn right onto Overland Road and go 0.3 miles to Butterfield Road. Turn left and 0.3 miles to the junction with Wells Fargo Road. Turn right and go 0.2 miles to a sign for Turley Trailhead, on the right. This sign may be hard to see from the road. Turn right up a narrow driveway and proceed 0.1 miles, through a gate, to the parking area. Please close gate behind you. Parking is good.

Alternately, to reach TR 62, travel east on Hwy 69 to Walker Road. Turn right and travel 0.6 miles to the trailhead on the right. The trailhead is signed. There is a large parking area with room for 12 vehicles on the south side and up to 10 horse trailers on the north side.

**TRAVEL TIME:** 10 minutes from Prescott to Turley Trailhead


**ROAD CONDITIONS:** Paved

**HIKING TIME:** 30 minutes, one-way **LENGTH:** 0.9 miles **DIFFICULTY:** Moderate **USE:** Light

**NOTES:** This is an internal trail that must be accessed via TR 62 or the Turley Trail. It is several miles to TR 126 from either access point.

**RECOMMENDED SEASONS OF USE:** Spring, summer, fall


