

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS AND AREA

OKANOGAN-WENATCHEE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited within the area of National Forest System (NFS) lands, trails, roads and routes as shown in Exhibit A and described in Exhibit B on the Entiat and Wenatchee River Ranger Districts, Okanogan-Wenatchee National Forests.


1. Using any motorized vehicle on the roads listed when gated, barricaded and/or closure notice posted. (36 CFR 261.54(A)).
2. It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. (36 CFR 261.53(e)).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


Violations of this prohibition are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. (Title 16 U.S.C. 551 and 19 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)

EXHIBIT B

Starting from the northernmost point of the Fire Area Closure at Maverick Saddle:

1. FSR 6101 closed at Maverick Saddle to junction with FSR 5200,
2. FSR 5200 south to FSR 7520 (at French Corral),
3. FSR 7520 south to FSR 7500,
4. FSR 7500 east and south to FSR 7415 (Swakane Road),
5. FSR 7415 southeast to US 97 Alt,
6. US 97 Alt north to Entiat River Road,
7. Entiat River Road to Mad River Road,
8. West of Mad River north to Maverick Saddle.


Assessment of Need and Enforcement Plan

Background: An emergency closure order is necessary for public safety due to a large wildfire in the Mills Canyon, area on the Entiat Ranger District. It is prudent to close these roadways until the fire is suppressed and the area is safe for public occupancy. Only Agency personnel or those persons involved in fire fighting and suppression activities or law enforcement patrols are allowed access under this permit. This closure is based on recommendations of the District Ranger, Fire personnel, and law enforcement personnel due to public safety and fire fighter safety concerns.

Intent of Closure: To provide for public safety during the time that wildfire hazards remain.

Enforcement Plan: The following activities need to occur to implement this special order in a manner that results in public acceptance and safety:
