**JENNY CREEK RESTORATION AREA AND MOTORIZED USE CLOSURE**

Pursuant to Title 16, U.S.C. § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited within the Boulder Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest, in Gilpin County, Colorado, west of the town of Rollinsville, and near Rollins Pass and the Rollins Pass/Moffat Road, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Area, Roads and Trail as depicted on Exhibit A on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order. The purpose of this Order is to provide for the protection of public health and safety during the Jenny Creek Restoration and Motorized Trail Reroute Project.

The Restricted Area, Roads and Trails are defined as:

**Closure 1: Jenny Creek Restoration Closure Area**

National Forest System lands within 1/8<sup>th</sup> mile from the south side of Jenny Creek to the north and on the east side where Jenny Creek crosses the Jenny Creek Road NFSR 502.1 and continuing west along the Jenny Creek Trail NFST 808.1 for ½ mile. These lands are found in T. 1 S., R. 74 W. sections 25 and 26. These lands are closed to all uses, both motorized and nonmotorized.

**Closure 2: Jenny Creek Roads Closure**

National Forest System Roads NFSR 502.1 from its junction with Moffat Road 149 east to the eastern edge of T. 1 S., R. 74 W. section 30 as well as all of NFSR 502.3A. These roads are found in T. 1 S., R. 74 W. sections 25 and 36; T. 1 S., R. 73 W. section 30. These roads are closed to all motorized uses. Nonmotorized uses are allowed.

**Closure 3: Jenny Creek Trail Closure**

National Forest System Trail 808.1 from its junction on the west with the Moffat Road 149 and east to the east where it joins Closure 1, which is ½ mile west of the crossing of Jenny Creek with the Jenny Creek Road NFSR 502.1. These lands are found in T. 1 S., R. 74 W. sections 26 and 27. This trail is closed to all motorized uses. Nonmotorized uses are allowed.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System Lands within the Restricted Area (Closure 1). 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e)
2. Using any type of motorized vehicle on the Restricted Roads (Closure 2). 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e)
3. Using any type of motorized vehicle on the Restricted Trail (Closure 3). 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty;
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission; and

This Order will be in effect and when posted and signed on the ground and shall remain in effect until rescinded or until December 31, 2014, whichever event occurs first.
