FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on the on National Forest System Lands administered by the Beartooth Ranger District of the Custer Gallatin National Forest.

The following acts are prohibited until further notice:

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire or campfire unless noted in the exemptions below. 36 CFR 261.52(a)
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials. 36 CFR 261.52(d)


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- a. Persons building, maintaining or attending a fire, or campfire, or stove fire in Developed Recreations Sites or Wilderness Area listed in Attachment A of this order.
- b. Persons using a device solely fueled by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels that can be turned on and off. Such devices can only be used in an area that is barren or cleared of all overhead and surrounding flammable materials within 3 feet of the device.
- c. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- d. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This Special Order is effective at 0001 a.m. Mountain Daylight Time on August 13th, 2014.

**Absaroka-Beartooth Wilderness is exempt from restrictions**

**Campgrounds:** Sheridan, Rattin, Parkside, Greenough, Limber Pine, M-K, Palisades, Basin, Cascade, Jimmy Joe, East Rosebud, Pine Grove, Emerald Lake, Woodbine, Initial Creek, Sage Creek

**Recreation day-use sites:** Wild Bill Lake, Sand Dunes, Old Nye, Big Ice Cave
