**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System road described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Mountain Home Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until further notice:

1. Using any type of motorized or mechanized vehicle on National Forest System Road #132 (Pinto Creek Road) as described below. **36 CFR § 261.54(a)**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**DESCRIPTION**

**National Forest System (NFS) #132 (aka Pinto Creek Road)** is described as beginning at the junction of NFSR #132D located within Township 4 North, Range 10 East, Section 14, then traveling generally northwest to the end of the road. The described road is within the Mountain Home Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Elmore County, Idaho.

**PURPOSE**

To provide for public safety due to road damage and washouts.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the road is attached to and made part of this order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581(b)(7)
4. This order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same, or similar acts for the above described road or portions thereof.


