**ROAD CLOSURE
NFS Road #255 (Roaring River Road)
For public safety**

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System road described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Mountain Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until further notice:

1. Using any type of motorized or mechanized vehicle on National Forest System Road #255 (Roaring River Road) as described below. **36 CFR § 261.54(a)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

DESCRIPTION

National Forest System (NFS) #255 (aka Roaring River Road) is described as beginning at the junction of NFSR #290 located within Township 5 North, Range 8 East, Section 25, then traveling generally north to the near end of the road, adjacent to the Roaring River Bridge located within Township 5 North, Range 9 East, Section 7. The described road is within the Mountain Home Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Elmore County, Idaho.


PURPOSE

To provide for public safety due to road damage and washouts.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the road is attached to and made part of this order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7)
4. This order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same, or similar acts for the above described roads or portions thereof.




**Roaring River Road
