*SOUTH FORK SALMON RIVER ROAD RESTRICTION  
(For Public Safety)*

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the road described in this order, all within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Krassel Ranger District, Payette National Forest. This order will remain in effect from September 3, 2014 until September 18, 2014.

1. Being on the road: including vehicles and foot traffic. **36 CFR 261.54 (e)**

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**ROAD DESCRIBED:**

**National Forest System Road #674** (also known as South Fork Salmon River Road): to include the shoulder of the road. The Southern closure point will begin at the Payette and Boise National Forest Boundary located in Township 16 North, Range 6 East, Section 1 continuing North 6.6 miles to immediately South of the entrance to the Poverty Flat Campground located in Township 17 North, Range 6 East, Section 11.

The above described road is located within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the Krassel Ranger District, Payette National Forest, Valley County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

**PURPOSE:**

The above described road is closed to all motorized vehicles and foot traffic in order to provide for public safety during culvert replacements and retaining wall construction on the South Fork Salmon River Road. The road will be closed September 3, 2014 and will reopen September 19, 2014 upon construction completion.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect beginning September 3, 2014 and shall remain in effect through September 18, 2014.
2. A map identifying the roads and areas is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. Further information regarding this Order may be obtained at the Krassel Ranger District located in McCall, ID, telephone number 208-634-0600, and at the Payette National Forest Supervisor's Office in McCall, ID, telephone number 208-634-0700.
5. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same, or similar acts covered in the above described area and or road.

## **ASSESSMENT OF NEED & ENFORCEMENT PLAN**

### **South Fork Salmon River Road Closure Special Order**

**Order Number: 0412-464**

#### **PAYETTE NATIONAL FOREST**

**1. Background:** The South Fork Salmon River road 50674 is in need of repair in four different locations between the Poverty Flat Campground and the Payette/Boise Forest boundary. The site with the most earth work is just south of Poverty Flat campground, at a place where the road fill is failing, and a mechanically stabilized earth wall (MSE wall) is needed. There are two other locations where culverts need to be replaced. The road will need to be completely closed between September 3 and September 18, 2014 because the contractor will need to excavate the entire road in order to build the MSE wall and to replace the culverts.

**2. Intent of Subpart B order:**

This temporary road closure is designed to ensure public safety by restricting use of the road and road shoulder during road work with heavy machinery. Motorized use of the road as well as the shoulder will be prohibited during the reconstruction work.

**3. Enforcement Plan:**

The contractor will install a barricade with a ROAD CLOSED sign at either end of the road closure. ROAD CLOSED information signs will be placed at the beginning of the South Fork Road #474 on the Boise National Forest near the junction of Warm Lake Highway and the South Fork Road #474 as well as at the junction of the East Fork Road #412 and the South Fork River Road #674.

Public notices will be distributed to the news media.

Forest Service Officers will make public contacts during patrol along the road in order to gain compliance.


