Portion of Gum Springs Horse Trail Temporarily Closed

Pineville, La. (August 15, 2014) – The Winn Ranger District is temporarily closing a small portion of the Gum Springs horse trail for bridge work until September 25, 2014. The area of trail closed is approximately three miles long and is located east of the Range Road (FDR 517) and south of the Calvin-Natchitoches Road (FDR 535).

“Even though this 3-mile area of the Gum Springs Horse trail is closed for some bridge work, we want to encourage horse riders to still come out and enjoy the trail. When you combine the mileage of the inner and the outer loop, Gum Springs horse trail is about 22 miles long. So there are plenty of miles to ride, explained Barbara Pool, Recreation Manager on the Winn Ranger District.
