FOREST ORDER
Temporary Fire Restrictions

Pursuant to 36CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the Siuslaw National Forest:

- (a) Building, maintaining, attending or using a campfire, fire, or stove fire when not in a pre-installed fire enclosure at a maintained USFS site listed in Attachment A or in dispersed recreation areas of the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area (ODNRA) or the Sand Lake Recreation Area.**

§36 CFR 261.52(a)

Exceptions:

- a. Those locations noted in Attachment A
 - b. The use of a pressurized liquid gas stove, pressurized liquid gas fire, pressurized liquid gas lantern or an enclosed solid fuel fire that utilizes a wick to distribute a flame are exempt from this order.
- (b) Smoking except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site or while in an area of at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material.**

§36 CFR 261.52(d)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. **Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.**
2. **Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force while in the performance of an official duty.**
3. **Persons building, maintaining, attending or using a campfire within campfire rings established by the Forest Service at developed recreation areas listed in Exhibit A or in dispersed recreation areas of the ODNRA or the Sand Lake Recreation Area.**

4. Persons using or maintaining portable cooking stoves using liquefied or bottled fuel.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A and other published Forest Orders in existence on the Siuslaw National Forest.
