## Recreation Report

August 26, 2014

**TRAVELING:** A reminder that it's Labor Day Weekend with a lot of activities going on, contributing to an increase in traffic across the area. Watch for heavy traffic heading over Cedar Pass for Burning Man. This holiday and all year, keep safety in mind whenever you're on the road.

**FIRE:** Fire restrictions are in effect across the forest which means no campfires are allowed except in the South Warner Wilderness with a valid permit and in designated recreation sites. The list of recreation sites is posted on the forest website.

Always use caution when having campfires. A campfire should not be unattended at any time. Extinguish your fire by pouring water on all ashes and using a shovel to stir the embers; use the back of your hand to feel that nothing is warm or smoldering. Be careful not be burned by any stray hot embers.

**CAMPING:** All campgrounds are open. There is no water at Headquarters Campground at the Medicine Lake area. Boil water advisories are posted at Patterson Campground, Stough Reservoir and Cave Lake Campground.

**WEATHER:** Remember, lightning is common in the high country during the summer. If possible, plan travel on high ground and open areas early in the day before the afternoon cumulus cloud buildup.

**ROADS:** Be alert to logging trucks and heavy equipment on Forest Road (FR) 44N02, County Road 73 (Crowder Flat), FR 43N36 and the 46 Road.

**WOODCUTTING:** All areas are open for wood cutting. For further information please check the woodcutting recording at 530-233-8819

**SOUTH WARNER WILDERNESS:** East Creek is not recommended for travel due to snag hazards. Raider Basin on Owl Creek Trail is impassable to hiker and pack stock. The condition of all other trails and trail segments is unknown at this time.
