ROAD CLOSURE
NFS Road #435B (Deer Creek Road)
For public safety due to road damage

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System road described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until further notice:

1. Using any type of motorized or mechanized vehicle on National Forest System Road #435 (Deer Creek Road) as described below, 36 CFR § 261.54(a).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this order is to provide for the protection of public health and safety. The road is closed due to road damage caused by recent high intensity rainfall events.

ROAD CLOSURE DESCRIPTION


National Forest System (NFS) #435 (aka Deer Creek Road) is described as beginning at the junction of NFS Road #435 located within Township 14 North, Range 2 East, Section 13, then traveling northerly to the end of the road. The described road is within the Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Valley County, Idaho.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the road is attached to and made part of this Order.

3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.


1. Background. A recent high intensity rainfall event caused significant damage to National Forest System Road #435B, the Deer Creek Road.

2. Intent of Subpart B order. This temporary road closure is for all motorized and mechanized access to promote public safety during the repair of the NFSR #435B.


3. Enforcement Plan. On ground signing and temporary barricades to advise the public of the temporary road closure will be installed and maintained at the junction of NFSR #435 and NFSR #435B. On site FS administrative personnel will make compliance contacts as needed.


