Hunting Season in Kisatchie National Forest

Pineville, La. (September 9, 2014) – With the first day of fall just around the corner, outdoorsmen in Louisiana know hunting season has arrived. Kisatchie National Forest (KNF), the only national forest in the state of Louisiana, encompasses 603,000 acres of land spread over seven central and north Louisiana parishes. Hunting is the most popular recreational activity that takes place on the KNF. The careful management of the forest throughout the year provides for an abundance of game.

All KNF hunting seasons for 2014 – 2015 are described in the Louisiana Hunting Regulations publication distributed by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries located on pages 104 - 109. “Louisiana is known as a sportsman’s paradise and Kisatchie National Forest is one of the best places to hunt” said Jim Caldwell, Staff Officer for Public Affairs, Recreation and Heritage. “We encourage hunters to utilize the great resource that is their national forest.”
