FOREST ORDER

Being in the area for public health and safety until hazard trees are mitigated.

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR Part 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited within the boundaries of the Umpqua National Forest as shown in Exhibit A – Area Map, due to hazardous trees in the Williams Creek dispersed camping area. The order is effective beginning August 28th, 2014 and ending on August 15, 2015, unless rescinded sooner.

1) Public Health and Safety

[36 CFR 261.53(e)]

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State, or local Officer of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both. [16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571].
