The Uinta-Wasatch-Cache (UWC) National Forest is outreaching to fill one permanent full-time (PFT) GS-0460-07/09 Pre-Sale Forester on the north zone of the UWC.

The duty station is Evanston, Wyoming. The selected individual will have responsibilities on the Evanston-Mountain View, Ogden, and Logan ranger districts.

The Forest is located within one hour's drive of approximately two million people and is the closest Forest Service office to the Utah State Capitol and the headquarters of many state and federal agencies and organizations important to the Forest Service. The Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest is one of the most visited Forests in the nation and balancing the demands of hundreds of thousands of outdoor enthusiasts with the natural resources is a constant challenge. We are looking for people who can seek creative and innovative ways to implement our program of work on the ground and build upon the relationships we already have here.

Our North Zone Pre-Sale Forester position is currently vacant and we are looking for interested individuals. This position performs timber sale preparation duties across multiple ranger districts.

Responsibilities include evaluating and analyzing the project sale folder and conducting preliminary field reconnaissance. Assembling and reviewing the timber sales contract package. Determining, planning, and arranging for the resources needed to complete the layout of sales. Identifying and verifying the land status and environmental constraints affecting layout of the proposed projects on the ground. Reviewing, compiling and analyzing field data. Preparing and completing environmental documents. Preparing and ensuring quality of documentation such as detailed maps, timber sale appraisals, timber sales write up, advertisements, prospectus, and sample contracts for the sale. The pre-sale forester arranges for interviews with prospective timber purchasers, explains contract clauses, road development, and cutting practices. Monitors and oversees cruising and timber marking. Prepares general logging plans and verifies logging system settings. Utilizing appropriate document, determines sale boundaries, proper location of logging roads, acceptable marking and cutting methods, stumpage prices, and the requirements for brush disposal, erosion control, and stand improvement. Prepares a summary of all records acceptable for the final appraisal, sale contract preparation, and subsequent timber management activities.

One position will be filled. Duty Station is Evanston, Wyoming with workload on the Evanston-Mountain View, Ogden, and Logan Ranger Districts.

We are looking for someone who is energetic, creative, and flourishes in a team environment.
