Rules: Photos submitted must feature a subject within a wilderness area. Any wilderness area can be featured including our local wilderness areas; Red Buttes, Marble Mountain, Russian, Trinity Alps and Mt Shasta. Subjects can be related to scenery, wildlife, plants, livestock, people enjoying the wilderness, as long as it's in a wilderness area. Multiple winners may be selected in two age class categories; 17 and under as well as 18 and over. Winners will be recognized locally and awarded prize ribbons.

Entries must be the exhibitor's own work. Photos shall be submitted as an 8"x10" print. Mats, mounting board and illustration board are acceptable and may be of any color, but may not exceed 11"x14". Do not use foam-core board, picture frames, glass or hanging devices.

Photos will be displayed and judged at the "Wilderness Treasures – Celebrating 50 Golden Years!" event being held at the Tehama County Fairgrounds in Red Bluff, October 10-12, 2014.

Photos may be submitted at any of the Klamath National Forest Ranger District Offices or Supervisor's office during business hours by close of business Monday October 6, 2014.
