

ORDER
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE
TUSAYAN RANGER DISTRICT
KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands administered by the Kaibab National Forests, in Coconino County in the State of Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Possessing or using any type of motorized vehicle is prohibited on FR2615 from the physical closure north of Rain Tank Trick Tank to the vehicle turnaround in the NE ¼ of Section 4 on FR 2615, accessed from FR 306J, 36 CFR 261.54(a).
2. Being on the road in violation of posted road closure restrictions, 36 CFR 261.54 (d) and (e), 36 CFR 261.58(g).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
2. Person(s) with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

AREA DESCRIBED:

This order affects the Kaibab National Forest, Tusayan Ranger District within Townships 29 North, Range 2 East, including sections 4, 5, and 8; and National Forest System Road or Forest Road (FR) 2615 from physical closure in the NW ¼ of Section 8 to the vehicle turnaround in the NE ¼ of Section 4 on FR 2615, accessed from FR 306J. The area is locally known as Rain Tank Canyon.

POSSESSING/USING MOTORIZED VEHICLES is prohibited on FR2615 from the physical closure north of Rain Tank Trick Tank to the vehicle turnaround in the NE ¼ of Section 4 on FR 2615, accessed from FR 306J.

PURPOSE:

This order is needed to protect the natural resources and for public safety.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until May 28, 2016 or rescinded, whichever event occurs first.


EXHIBIT A: Temporary Road Closure (Order No. 07-14-02-E) Forest Road 2615
