Temporary Closure of 2.5 miles of Farley Cove Road (NFSR 407)


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.54(e) for the protection of public health and safety, the following act is prohibited on the last 2.5 miles of Farley Cove Road (NFSR 407) due to public safety concerns with logging operations along this portion of the road. This order is in effect from April 1, 2014 until October 30, 2014.

1) Being on the road. 36 CFR 261.54 (e).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from this order:

1. Persons with a special use permit or contract specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violations of these prohibitions set forth is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. See 16 U.S.C 551, 18 U.S.C. and 3571.
