
Pursuant to 36 C.F.R Sections 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited within 1000 feet of all sides of the Nantahala River and on islands within the river, from the junction of Wayah Road (SR 1310) and US 19 to the junction of Silvermine Road (SR1103) and US 19, as indicated on the closure map. This order is in effect from February 8, 2013 until February 8, 2018.

**1. Camping 36 CFR 261.58(e).**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the authorized Forest Service Officer specifically authorizing an otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
