

## Weekly Fall Color Update

**Forest Name & District:**  
Ozark National Forest, Mount Magazine, Ranger District 11/19/2014

<b>Color (or Expectation):</b>	The hickories are almost all brown now while the red and white oaks still have some yellow and orange colors.. There are only a few pops of color left, the majority are dull oranges and browns.
<b>Recommended Viewing Routes:</b>	Scenic state highway 309 is a recommended route for the fall colors as well as out top of Mt. Magazine.
<b>Estimated Peak Period:</b>	The estimated peak period has passed with a lot of the trees starting to lose their colors and starting to turn brown, but there are still some spots that have some color left in them!
<b>Temperature:</b>	The temperatures are a lot cooler now and range from 40-50s during the day and 20s and 30s through the night.
<b>Remarks:</b>	The fall colors might be over this year but they will definitely come back next year!
