

FOREST ORDER

SAN ISABEL NATIONAL FOREST

Occupancy and Use Restrictions
Agnes Vaille Trail, Trail Area and Trailhead Area

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Register (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on or within the Agnes Vaille Trail, Agnes Vaille Trail Area and Agnes Vaille Trailhead Area which are hereby described as those National Forest System lands and trail located in Section 21 and 28, T. 15 S., R. 79 W., New Mexico P.M., Chaffee County, Colorado, as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A.

The Agnes Trail Area is further described as that area within ¼ mile of the center of the Agnes Trail.

This order is needed to assure public health and safety after a large rockslide event.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Going into or being upon the Agnes Vaille Trail Area and Trailhead Area. C.F.R. § 261.53(e)
2. Being on the Agnes Vaille Trail. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force, in the performance of an official duty.

This order will be in effect upon signature and will remain in effect until October 1st, 2015 or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571
