

LeConte Bay Loop Route

Starting in Petersburg one could paddle southeast along the shoreline of Mitkof Island to Ideal Cove, and then at high tide cross the Frederick Sound tidal flats to LeConte Bay. After exploring LeConte Bay one would paddle northwest along the Horn Cliffs. The shortest paddle back across Frederick Sound is from Point Agassiz to the Sukoi Islets to the Kupreanof Island shore. This is best done at either slack tide. The final leg would be to paddle into the Petersburg harbor at high tide. This route is 75 miles and requires two major crossings and paddling the icebergs in LeConte Bay.
