- Pat Keyes Trail:**
- From US 395, drive east on Manzanar Reward Road 4.7 miles to road junction with embedded tire on north side of road.
 - Turn left, and drive north 1.1 miles to a road junction. An old corral is visible at base of mountains.
 - Turn right and drive east .5 miles to trailhead.

- Hiking to Winnedumah Paiute Monument:**
- From US 395, drive east on Mazourka Canyon Road 8.3 miles.
 - Turn right on to 36E401, drive through open gate, and climb eastward 2 miles on 4WD road to turnout on south side of road.
 - Hiking route follows old mining road north about 1.4 miles.
 - Route then goes cross-country generally northeast to ridgeline.
 - You will most likely travel south along ridge to reach the monument.
